This begins the most immediate and the most difficult part of the UFO/ET picture. By the end of this part, you will know that we are being interfered with by ETs; to what end we do not yet know.

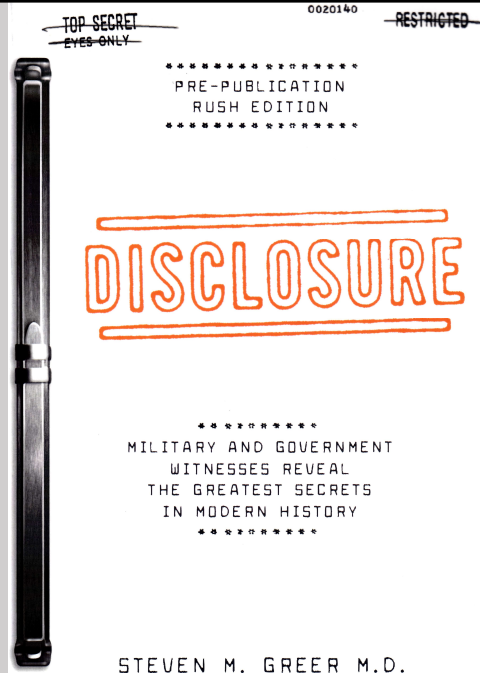
Again, there are suppositions galore, and serious reporting by a few very capable original researchers in the field; you will be introduced to most of them in the course of this discussion.

But first – an aside. I mentioned to you that I had met Steven Greer; that he had organized the Disclosure Press Conference in Washington DC in 2001, and that he was extremely active in the field – and doing it on his own in a way that has basically committed him 100% to it for many years now.

I never picked up this book that he edited until last summer – which was my mistake. It was published in 2001 – and I should have read it years ago. McGill Library has a print copy, so I have no excuse!

**Disclosure witnesses:
there are 68 of them.**

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The heart of the book is 68 narrative accounts by civilians who had worked for the government, former military people in every branch of service, and scientists and engineers who either worked for or interacted with the military or other branches of government. All of them are reports of close encounters with either ET vehicles or with ETs in a wide range of circumstances. Most of them are interviews with Greer; but others are independently written accounts.

There is so much eyewitness evidence here that an unbiased person sitting down to read the 573 pages would have to conclude that ETs are here and that they are messing with us.

the other "The Flying Saucers are Real" by Donald Keyhoe. Both books dealt mostly with the sightings of unidentified objects and both books claim that flying objects were of extra-terrestrial origin and might well be space ships from another planet. Sedley claimed that the preliminary studies of one saucer which fell into the hands of the United States Government indicated that they operated on some hitherto unknown magnetic principles. It appeared to me that our own work in geo-magnetics might well be the linkage between our technology and the technology by which the saucers are designed and operated. If it is assumed that our geo-magnetic investigations are in the right direction, the theory of operation of the saucers becomes quite straightforward, with all observed features explained qualitatively and quantitatively.

I made discreet enquiries through the Canadian Embassy staff in Washington who were able to obtain for me the following information:

- a. The matter is the most highly classified subject in the United States Government, rating higher even than the H-bomb.
- b. Flying saucers exist.
- c. Their modus operandi is unknown but concentrated effort is being made by a small group headed by Doctor Vannevar Bush.
- d. The entire matter is considered by the United States authorities to be of tremendous significance.

I was further informed that the United States authorities are investigating along quite a number of lines which might possibly be related to the saucers such as mental phenomena and I gather that they are not doing too well since they indicated that if Canada is doing anything at all in geo-magnetics they would welcome a discussion with suitably accredited Canadians.

While I am not yet in a position to say that we have solved even the first problems in geo-magnetic energy release, I feel that the correlation between our basic theory and the available information on saucers checks too closely to be mere coincidence. It is my honest opinion that we are on the right track and are fairly close to at least some of the answers.

Mr. Wright, Defence Research Board liaison officer at the Canadian Embassy in Washington, was extremely anxious for me to get in touch with Doctor Solandt, Chairman of the Defence Research Board, to discuss with him future investigations along the line of geo-magnetic energy release. I do not feel that we have as yet sufficient data to place before Defence Research Board which would enable a program to be initiated within that organization, but I do feel that further research is necessary and I would prefer to see it done within the framework of our own organization with, of course, full co-operation and exchange of information with other interested bodies.

I discussed this matter fully with Doctor Solandt, Chairman of Defence Research Board, on November 20th and placed before him as much information as I have been able to gather to date. Doctor Solandt agreed that work on geo-magnetic energy should go forward as rapidly as possible.

Smith's conclusions are summarized above.

He was able to start a small Canadian government-funded project to study the effects of UFOs on the earth's electromagnetic field. They disrupt that field as they fly above earth, and the disruptions can be measured if you have the right instruments.

His report is a historical document of significance.

and offered full co-operation of his board in providing laboratory facilities, acquisition of necessary items of equipment, and specialized personnel for incidental work in the project. I indicated to Doctor Solandt that we would prefer to keep the project within the Department of Transport for the time being until we have obtained sufficient information to permit a complete assessment of the value of the work.

It is therefore recommended that a PROJECT be set up within the frame work of this Section to study this problem and that the work be carried on a part time basis until such time as sufficient tangible results can be seen to warrant more definitive action. Cost of the program in its initial stages are expected to be less than a few hundred dollars and can be carried by our Radio Standards Lab appropriation.

Attached hereto is a draft of terms of reference for such a project which, if authorized, will enable us to proceed with this research work within our own organization.

His recommendation: "a project be set up .. to study this problem ... cost of the project in its initial stages are expected to be less than a few hundred dollars and can be carried out by our Radio Standards Lab appropriation."

A few hundred dollars! Since then at least a few hundred billion have been spent, very quietly, studying the same problem, by more than one government.

Greer's "brief summary" (p. 13):

..we are indeed being visited by extraterrestrial civilizations and have been for some time.

..this is the most classified compartmentalized program within the US and many other countries.

.. these projects, as warned in 1961 by President Eisenhower, escaped legal oversight in the US, the UK and elsewhere.

.. advanced spacecraft of extraterrestrial origin..(ETVs)..have been downed, retrieved and studied since at least the 1940s and possibly as early as the 1930s.

..significant technological breakthroughs in energy generation and propulsion have resulted from the study of these objects..

..above top-secret projects possess fully operational antigravity propulsion devices...

And here in a nutshell is what Greer's informants report:

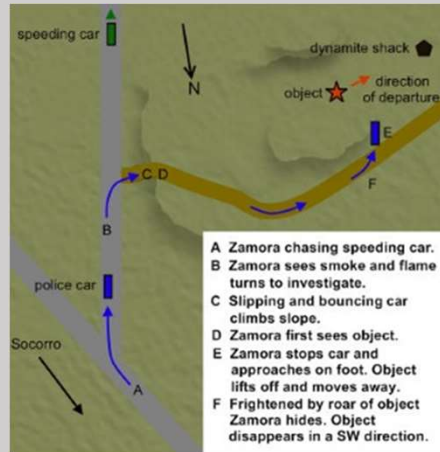
1. Visitation by ETs has happened for a long time.
2. US and other governments know this and have been studying every aspect secretly for a long time.
3. There is a "deep state" not beholden to Congress, that spends US tax dollars studying ETs and ETVs without any accountability.
4. Antigravity propulsion has been reverse engineered from crashed ETVs.
5. Efficient power generation has been reverse engineered from crashed ETVs.

...why should a report of a car stopped on the highway by a blinding light from an unknown craft be any different in essential strangeness or absurdity from one of a craft from which two or three little animate creatures descend?

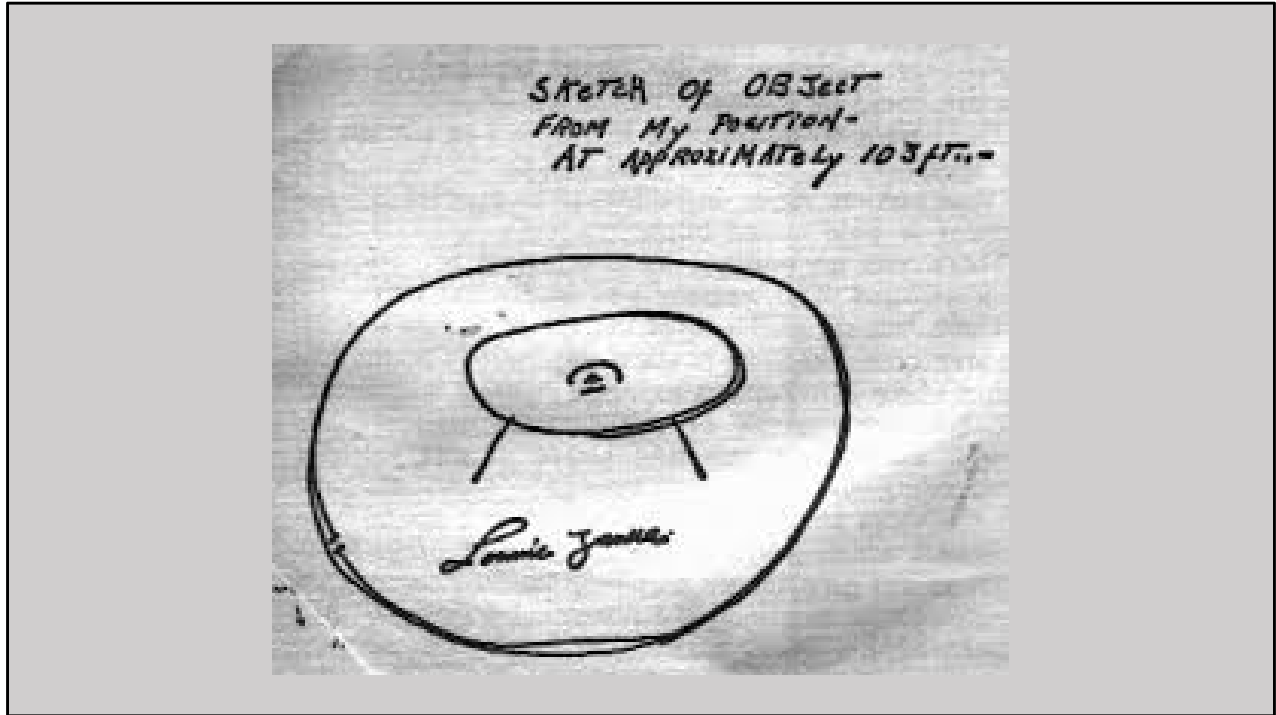

Now, back to the main topic: occupants and abductions. J. Allen Hynek and others mentioned abductions, but with great caution – and NICAP, the early UFO group, was suspicious and kept the “occupant” observations and the “abduction” observations at arm’s length for many years.

Lonnie Zamorra:
Socorro, New Mexico: April 24, 1964



A well-documented case with at least two witnesses and “Blue Book” follow-up. A reputable local policeman saw an ellipsoid shaped UFO land in a gully near Socorro, NM in 1964. Other witnesses saw it as well, and there was followup by the USAF Project Blue Book, which was in operation at the time. Verdict: unexplained.



Here is Zamorra's sketch of what he saw: along with the occupants, who were dressed in some kind of white suit.

Of UFO Landing Here Observed

City Policeman Zamora Reports Sighting Egg-Shaped Object and Views Take-Off; Tourist Sees Craft Just Before Landing

Santa Fean Reports Seeing UFO Landed North of Espanola

What appears to be substantial evidence of an unidentified flying object landing and taking off in Socorro has been observed.

City Policeman Lonnie Zamora, a highly reliable source, saw a four-legged, egg-shaped object, and two persons in a gully a mile south of the overgrown area shortly before 9 p.m. Friday. He saw the object rise straight up and take off just after midnight on the west side of the gully.

Some of the evidence of the landing and take-off remains in the gully. There were four shallow holes where the object apparently landed on the sand. There were burned grasswood and several chunks of green grass.

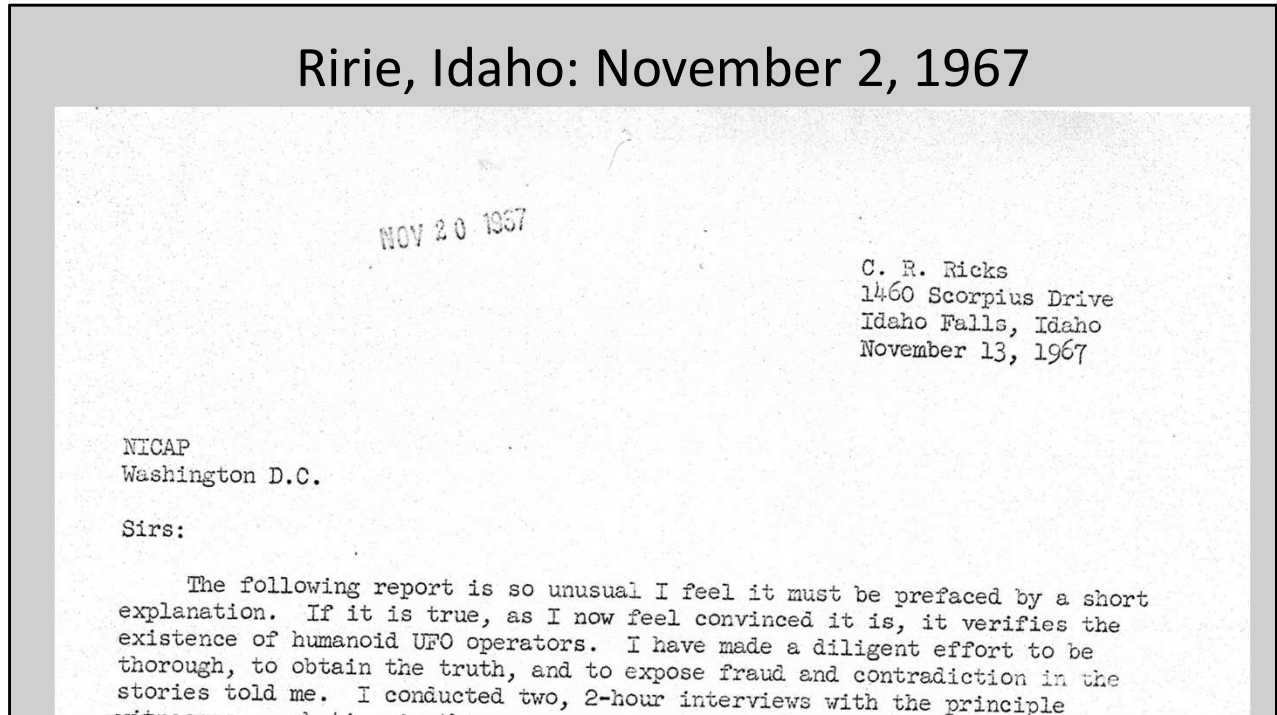
Gallegos later told State Police he saw the object sitting on the ground in a gravel area when he went outside to check water hose. He did not approach closer than 200 feet. He noticed the object on the side of the CPO, and he knocked the landing on a paper sack after the object had taken off. He did not believe the landing was in English and he observed no sounds as there was no known aircraft. Zamora said he was not at liberty to discuss the landing.

Where UFO Landed in Socorro: State Police Sgt. Sam Chavez and Lorna A. Bedell, publisher of El Defensor-Chieftain, stand at one of the stone-crater depressions (arrow) made by an unidentified flying object which landed in a park a mile from the courthouse last Friday. The arrow in left foreground points to another depression made by a foot. Near the center foreground are burned grasswood and clumps of grass. The person at the left also looks over the scene, which had not been trampled by the curious Saturday morning when the photo was taken.

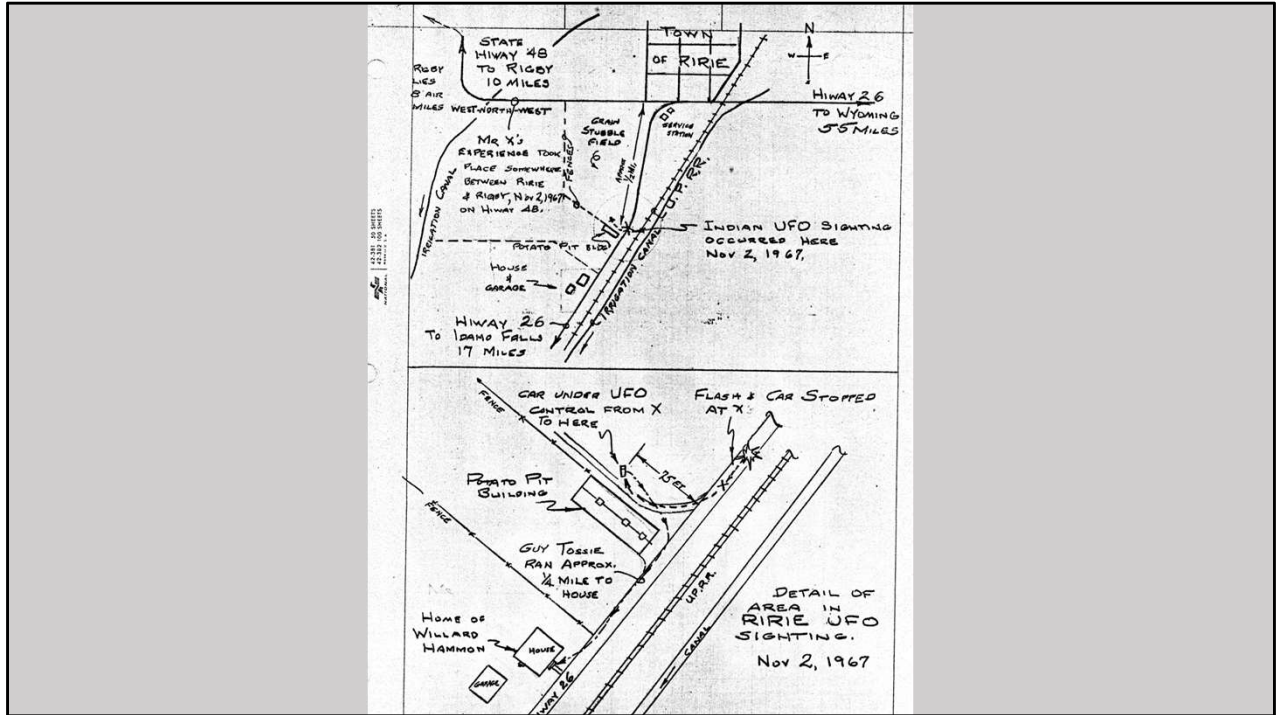

Local and national publicity; USAF and police were on the scene.

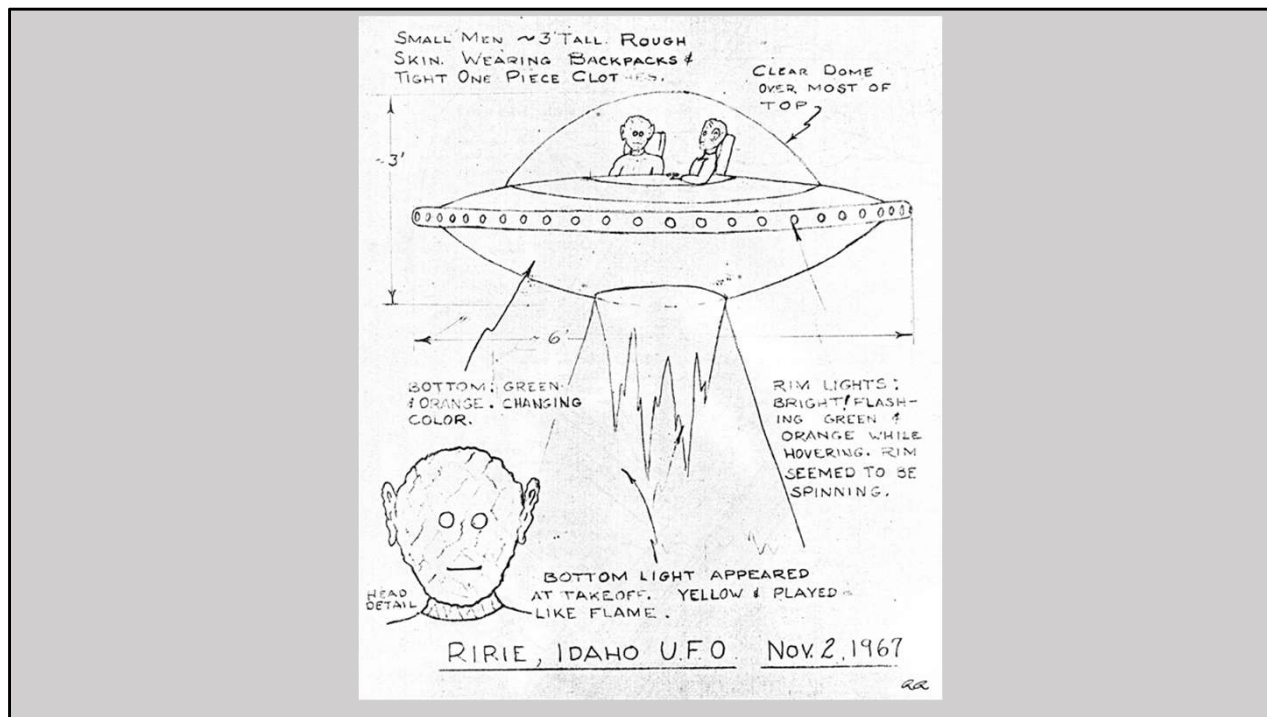
Ririe, Idaho: November 2, 1967



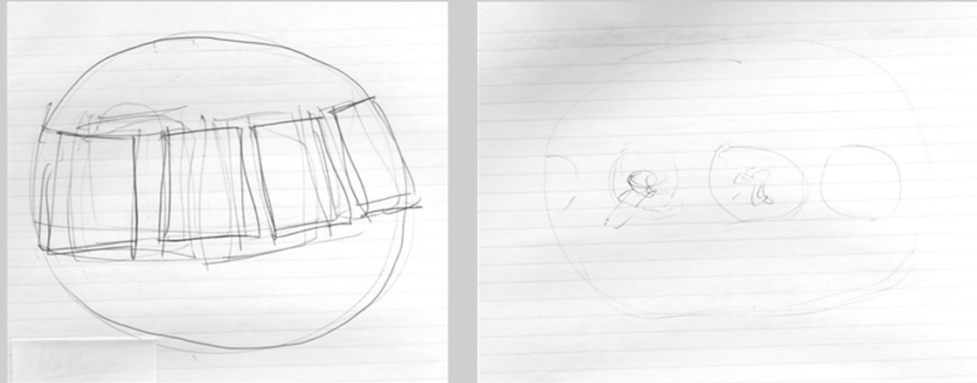
NICAP (National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena: Keyhoe and the ex-director of the CIA) got involved with “occupants” in 1968, and sent around a dossier of cases to a group of people on their Occupant review committee. The NICAP investigator carried out a thorough study. There were six “occupant” cases in all; in an occupant dossier that NICAP sent around to a panel of experts.



Here is a map locating the two occupant-involved sightings on the night of November 2, 1967.



As explained in my book, this case (along with five other occupant cases) was my first direct exposure to the phenomenon. I was asked to comment on it by NICAP, of which I was a member, along with other “occupant” cases they were trying to evaluate. I said, basically, let's set up video cameras and sensors and catch some “occupants” on film.

Sane Citizen Sees UFO in New Jersey



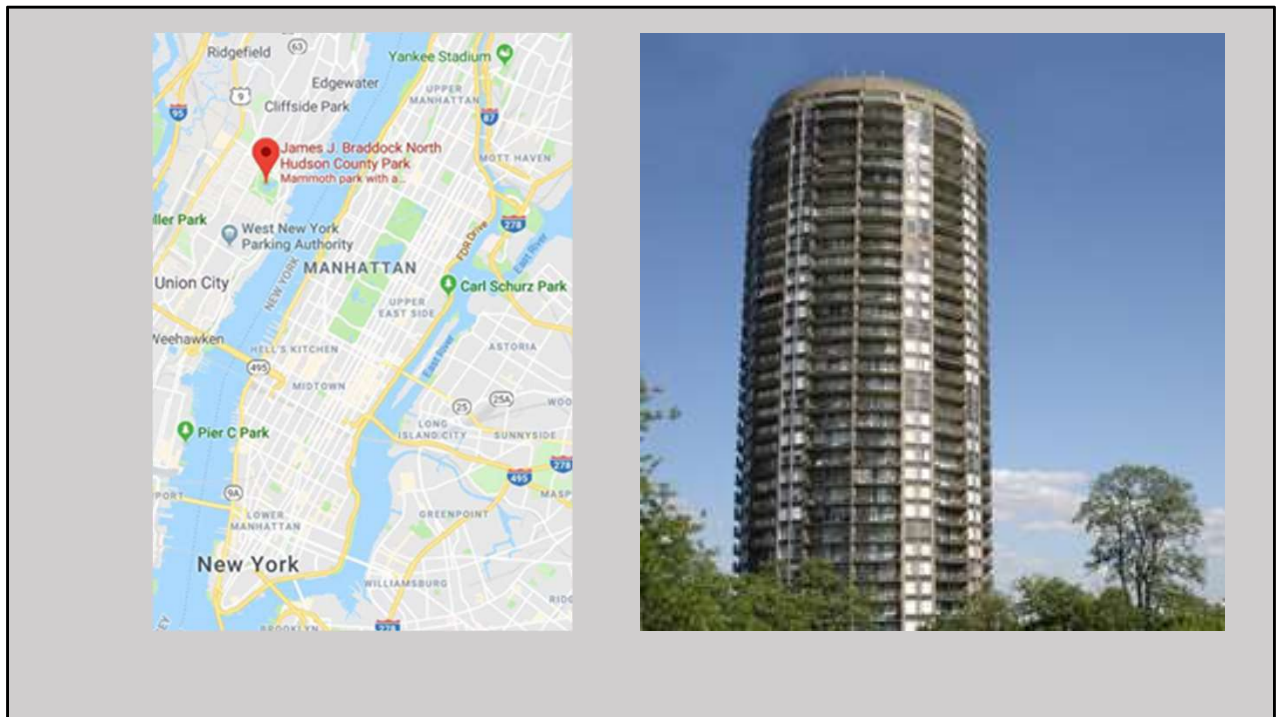

There is the headline of Hopkins' article in the Village Voice. There is one of his abstract expressionist paintings. There is George O'Barski, who saw the landed UFO and the occupants, and the Stonehenge apartment building on the Palisades.

Hopkins wrote five books: *Intruders*, *Missing Time*, *Witnessed*, *Sight Unseen*, and a memoir, *Art, Life and UFOs*.



This sighting had consequences beyond its impact on the witness: it got Budd Hopkins to take another look at UFOs – beyond the one he and others had seen on Cape Cod years before. It led him to write an article – which meant people began telling him their stories – and the rest is history (four books on the abduction experience).

Emily Trim



Emily Trim – and Luigi Vendittelli, from whom you heard her story. My wife and I have met Emily (more than once). She is a friend of Luigi's who has photographed and catalogued all of her art. I have seen just about everything in her portfolio, and it is remarkable.

In my untutored opinion, she would be acclaimed as a painter even without the UFO connection; but of course as Luigi explained her art was precipitated by her occupant experiences as a child in Zimbabwe.

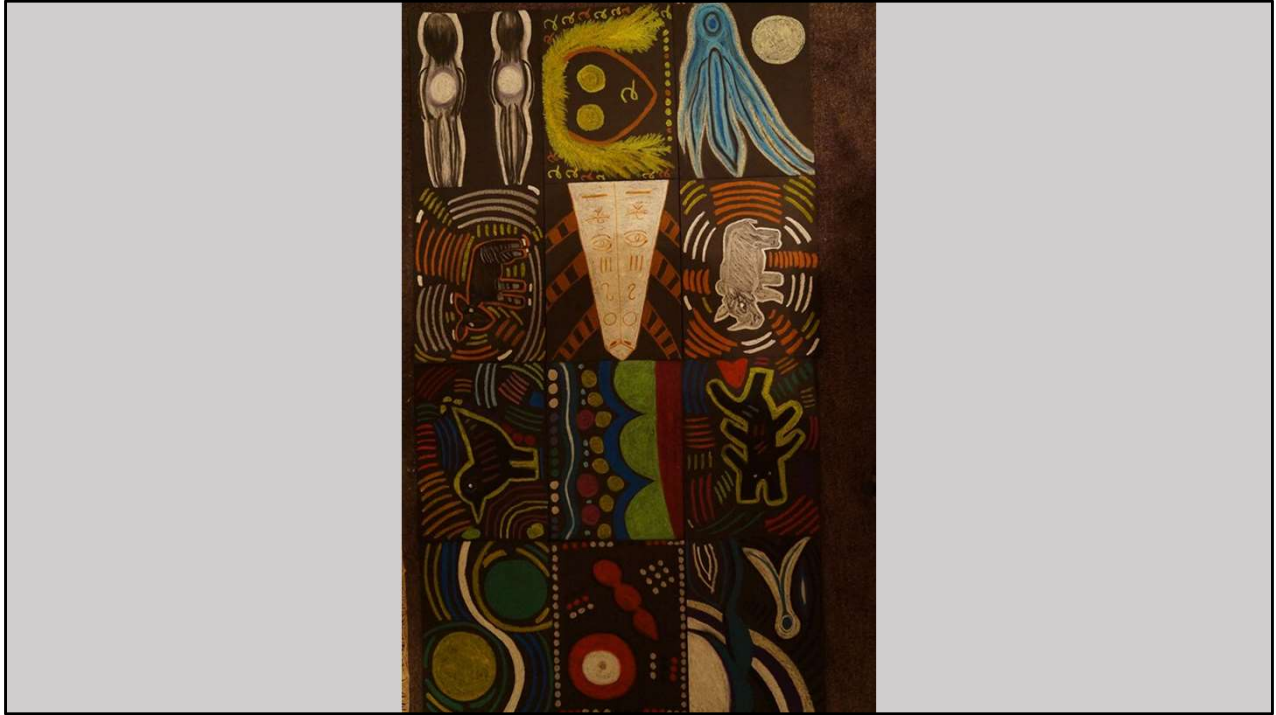

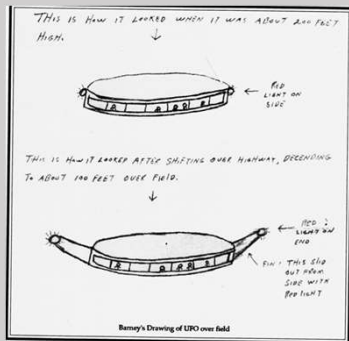

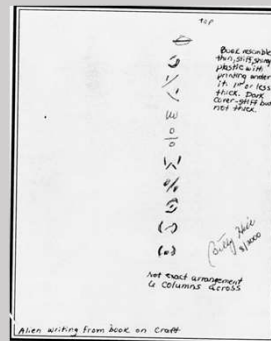

The classic case: the Barney and Betty Hill abduction, reported in two books. The investigation was thorough, the circumstances unusual, and the conclusion (at least by the psychiatrist who first investigated them) ambiguous.

I have met, and am currently working with Kathleen Marden, Betty Hill's niece, who is herself a UFO and abduction investigator.

Characteristics: remembered close encounter; missing time

1968: Buff Ledge Camp, North of Winooski, VT

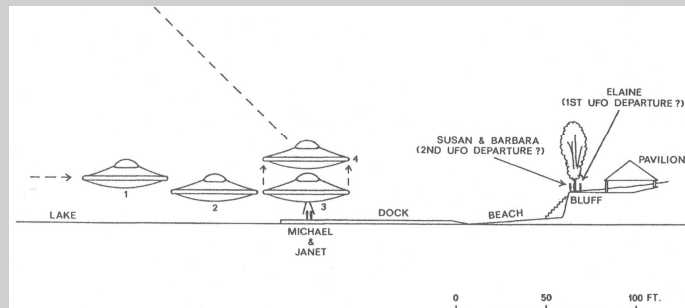
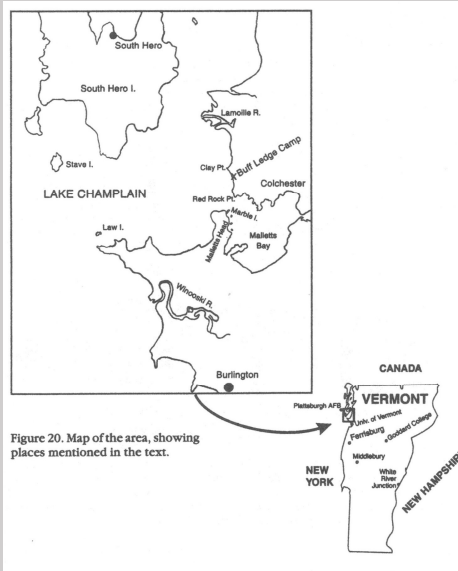


Figure 11. Profile view of camp waterfront showing UFO and positions of various witnesses. According to Michael, the UFO halted three times at close range during its initial approach—at about 60 feet from end of dock (1), 10 feet (2), and overhead (3). Position 3 also represents site of object's return to dock, and position 4 is elevated hover point prior to final departure. Diagram by the author.

Relatively close to us, and thoroughly investigated. Walter Webb is an astronomy professional, who was a manager at the Boston Planetarium and so was a professional interested in the phenomenon. The case is thoroughly described in his book, and is also summarized in mine.

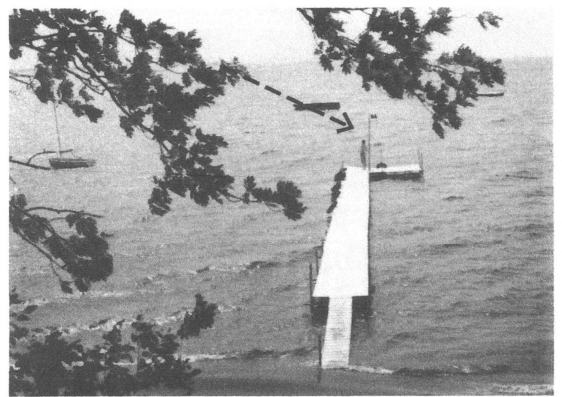


Figure 5. Close-encounter UFO followed the approximate path to the dock shown (drawn in by the author). Photo (1979) was taken from the top of the bluff steps. Susan Middleton and Barbara Bryant probably had this view in the final seconds of the encounter.

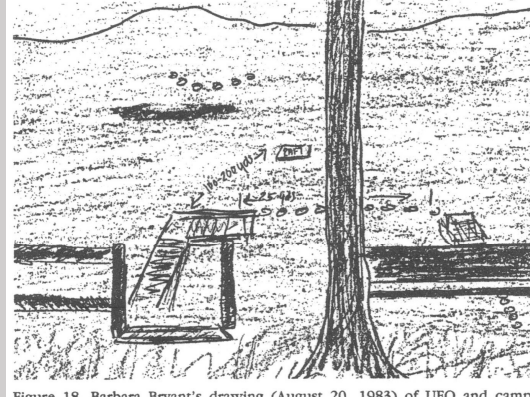
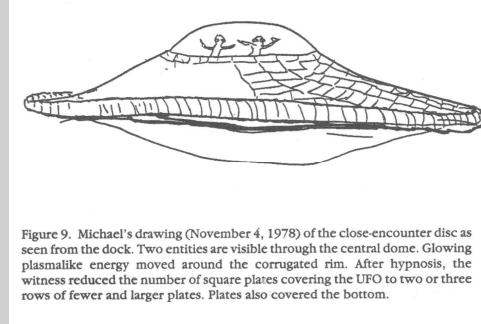
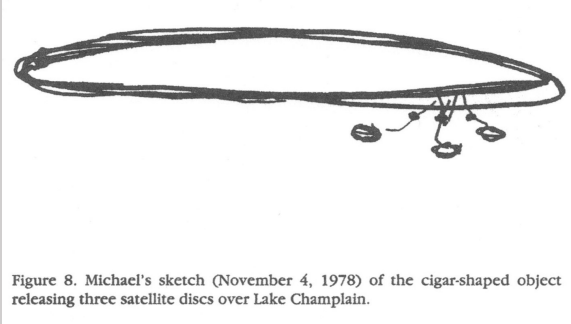


Figure 18. Barbara Bryant's drawing (August 20, 1983) of UFO and camp waterfront. The witness recalled standing on the bluff by the steps and viewing a curved row of lights below the darkened lake horizon (wavy line). A string of floats designates the swim area to the right of the dock. (The water-ski raft actually was some 80 yards from the dock.)

The *mise en scene*: a quiet corner of Lake Champlain; a quiet evening at camp, and only two counsellors left to experience the close encounter.

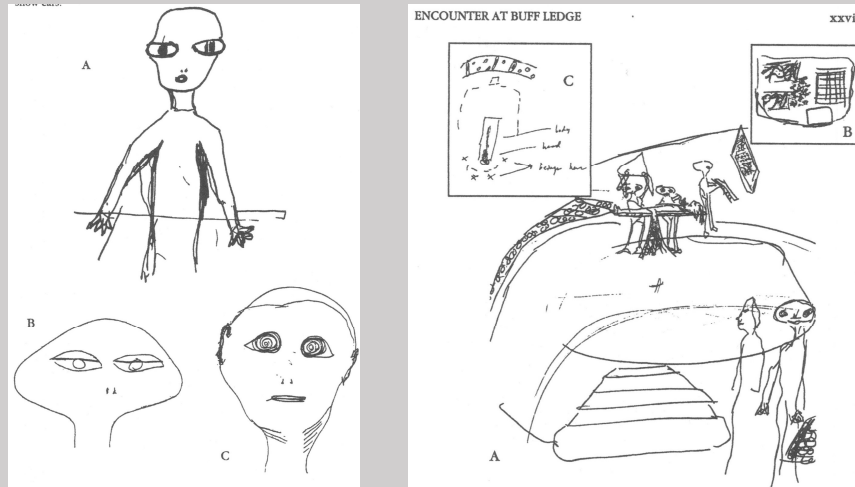
The follow-up took years, and involved finding other witnesses, arranging hypnosis sessions, and correlating witness reports.

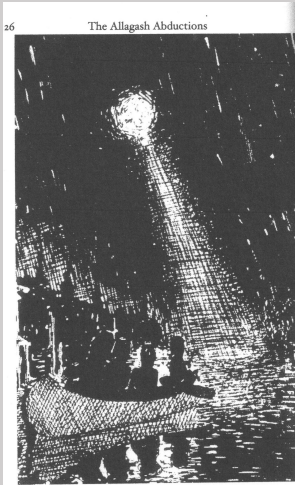


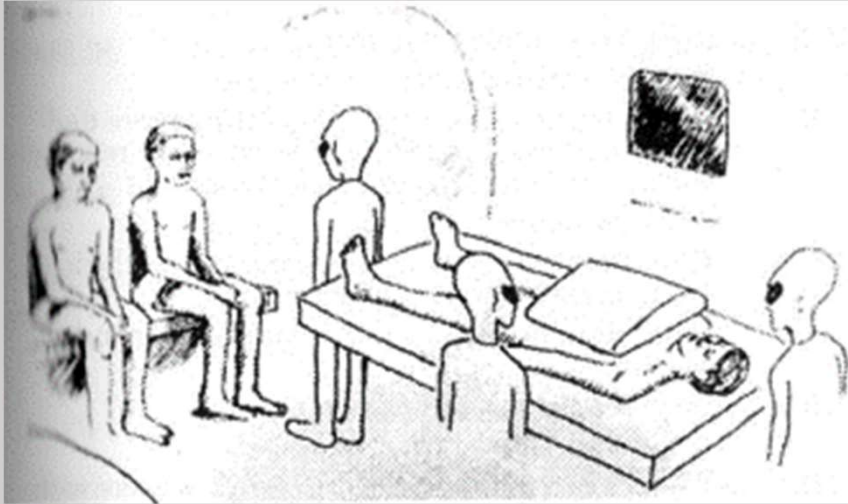
Figure 2. The Allagash four see the light in the sky.

Another thoroughly investigated case: multiple witnesses to a UFO close encounter; missing time, multiple reports of bad dreams, etc., followed up by hypnotic regression. The unusual feature: all of the witnesses were art students, and their drawings are a cut above the average.

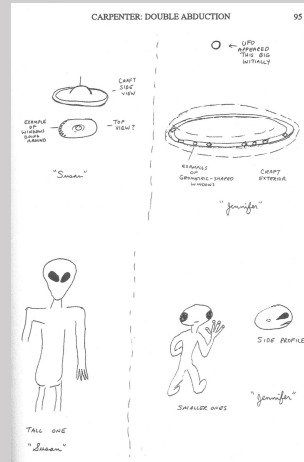
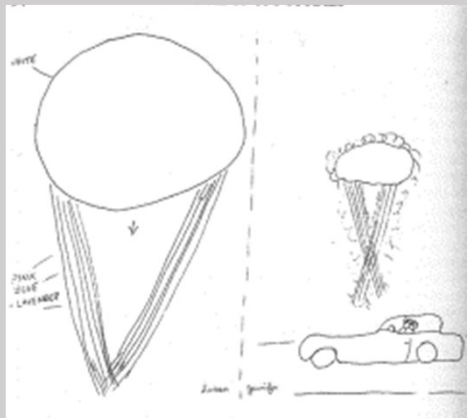


All of the abductees were examined aboard the craft, and some of them remember watching the other abductees be examined.

Their drawings differ in some respects, but show a type of reptilian occupant that has duplicates in other cases.

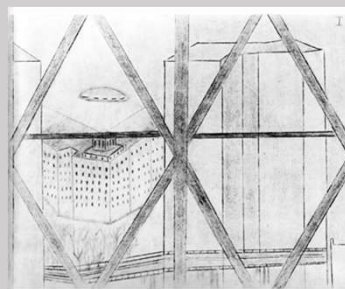
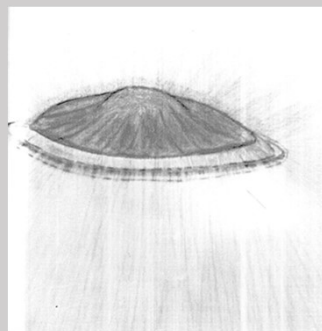
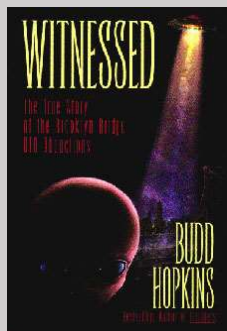

I have met the witnesses and the researcher in this case. They are ordinary people. There is, again, a remembered close encounter followed by missing time, and consistency between both abductees' reports.

November 30, 1989



Notice the date on this case: about three weeks after the previous case. Again, I knew the investigator and know the abductee. The case is thoroughly documented and there are multiple witnesses to the abduction itself.

There is again a remembered close encounter and missing time; again, the details are filled in through hypnotic regression (I sat in on one session).

David Jacob’s book *Walking Among Us* describes multiple abduction cases and outlines a disturbing scenario of ET intent with abductees and “hybrids”.

My wife and I had dinner with, and spent a long afternoon on the Thames Embankment, with “Sean Allen”, one of the abductees whose story is told in that book. He is a successful English businessman.

Her story is not unique. What is unique is that it is from rural Quebec. The chance of a malicious or self-aggrandizing story generated against this background is lower. I have met “Sylvie P” – and wrote the introduction to the book.

The most thorough investigator of abductions is David M. Jacobs, a retired history professor. His books review what he has learned about the abduction phenomenon as a result of many hours spent with abductees. His most recent book (2015) describes experiences of, among others, the “Sean Allen”, mentioned in an earlier slide.

Snowflake, AZ, 1975: Travis Walton

I have only reviewed cases where I am familiar either with the original literature or the investigator or both, and where I have more than common knowledge of the events. For these widely known cases, I know no more than any reader of the internet, so I mention them in passing only. Both do involve a remembered close encounter with missing time reviewed under hypnosis; both were widely publicized and highly controversial at the time.

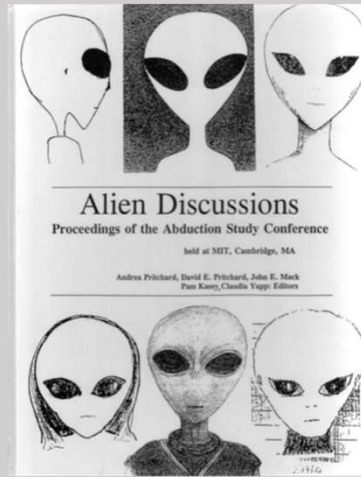
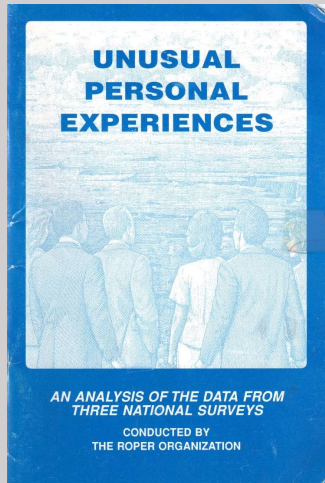

The Roper Poll and the Alien Discussions Conference (1992)

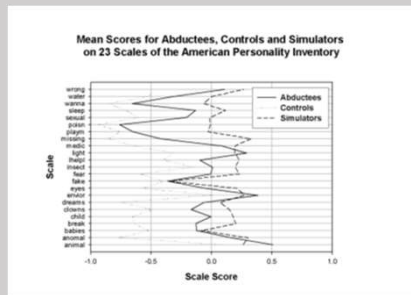


My first involvement in the abduction research area came about as a result of a discussion at an abduction conference held at MIT in 1992. I had suggested improvements to the analysis of data collected during an extensive random survey of Americans carried out in 1991.

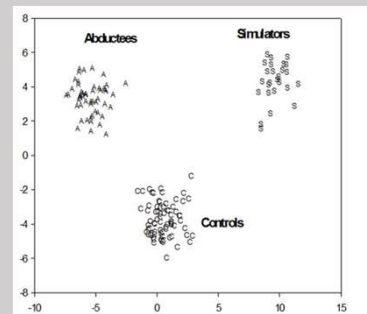
I suggested an elaborate and expensive re-analysis of the data that would have cost \$ 140 K plus and went nowhere. However it put me in contact with the poll sponsors.

The UFO Abduction Syndrome

I worked with the late Budd Hopkins, and Ted Davis, to evaluate a much longer test that they then created, based in part on standard psychometric tests that Davis (a social worker) knew well, and that they modified to access experiences that might indicate an abduction.

I did some of the testing and evaluation, and the work has been published. Follow-up studies were presented at the MUFON annual meeting in Cherry Hill, NJ (near Philadelphia PA) in July of 2018.
