
Budd Hopkins: Witnessed: The True Story of the Brooklyn Bridge UFO Abductions

I met "Linda" and another witness to this event through Budd Hopkins in the early 'nineties.

The two abductees discussed today are people I know. I have eaten dinner with them, talked to them, and walked or driven with then. I have heard more from them than is written about them.

As far as I can tell, the accounts that they have produced under hypnosis are true (I sat in on one session for this abductee, Linda Cortile).



Linda Cortile was abducted from her apartment on November 30, 1989.

She was levitated out of her apartment by three grays through a closed window.

The abduction was seen by people whose cars had been immobilized on the Brooklyn Bridge while the abduction took place.

The arrival of the UFO was seen by a witness living in an apartment in Manhattan.

The abduction was witnessed by two US Secret Service agents as well as the high-ranking international political figure whose security convoy had been immobilized during the abduction on a surface road near the Brooklyn Bridge.

This case is of course thoroughly documented in Budd Hopkin's book, "Witnessed." I have seen some, but not all, of the original documents supporting this case, including letters from some of the principals mentioned prominently in the book and summarized above.



The two secret service agents, and the international official, remained involved in Linda Cortile's life for years following the event.

The November 30, 1989 abduction was not Linda Cortile's first abduction. This is a common pattern among abductees.

The Secret Service agents were traumatized by the event: one of them very seriously. They had been involved in previous abductions.

Linda and the ETs communicated telepathically.

It is a family abduction story; and one which involves a large cast of characters and several different locations, both terrestrial and extra-terrestrial. The book is widely available if you care to follow up for yourself.



"Sean Allen"

He is one of the abductees who has worked with David Jacobs and whose experiences are described in "Walking Among Us." He is a successful UK businessman.

He was Introduced to me by a UK academic: Young-Hae Chi, Lecturer in the Oxford School of Oriental Studies.

I met "Sean Allen" in England. Unlike Linda Cortile, his picture has never been made public, so I won't.

We met on a trip I took to England in 2015, I gave a talk on UFOs at the invitation of an English colleague.

Don't think that's very special – the talk was attended by about as many people who attend each session of our course.

According to Jacobs, the job of many human abductees is to teach hybrids how to integrate into human society.

Aboard a UFO, Sean Allen teaches a hybrid to dance:

"She looks quite human...

There is no music so he has to teach her about "moving back and forth" without it.

"there were five or six pairs in the room – so I'm assuming that at least one of each pair was an abductee."

The hybrids know nothing about human social customs: dances, etc.

The female hybrid asked Sean about manicure details and about reading from books.

His hypnotically recalled accounts are recorded in Walking Among Us.. He interacts with the late-stage hybrids describe by Jacobs: Humanoids either completely or almost completely indistinguishable from homo sapiens, but with added telepathic abilities to control human thought and action.

Sean Allen finds his I Pod missing – it is missing for three days. On the fourth day it re-appears, and then one female and two male Hubrids visit him at home – in the middle of the night.

They want to know how to use an I Pod.

Other abductees interact regularly with Hubrids who are living – either on their own or in groups – on earth. The abductees guide the Hubrids in dealing with human civilization, because everything is unfamiliar to them: from busses to PayPal to common human interactions; with store clerks, strangers on the street, etc.

As this event suggests – and as Jacobs has documented in many cases – the advanced hybrids, who he calls "Hubrids" are embedded in human society, but they are not skilled at assimilating and need a lot of help. They get it from abductees – either aboard ETVs or at home.

Sean Allen told me that he has been abducted repeatedly – as has his friend Joanna.

He described being abducted by three gray aliens while staying at hotel in, I believe, Istanbul.

Another figure who was there looked like his grandfather.

He also told me that his conscious memories of UFOs went back to his childhood.

When he was younger he also saw UFOs – not directly connected to a remembered abduction experience – on various occasions in the UK.

A common story: abductions are long-term (for one individual) and often inter-generational.

Thought control is a recurrent feature of ET and hybrid telepathic abilities.





Next to it is Annie Jacobson's huge modern book on th same topic, called Phenomena, published in 2017. It's all about the US government's secret research on the topic, carried out from the end of WWII to –probably – the present.

The 'tinfoil hat' is of course the snide description of the thing that deluded people wear to protect themselves from rays, coming from outside, that are trying to take over their mind. Since the turn of the 20th century, we know that electromagnetic rays penetrate the human body (e.g. x-rays) and that has led people with concerns about thought control to wear a 'tinfoil hat' to insulate their head from the thought-changing rays.

Velostat is a packaging material made of a <u>polymeric</u> foil (<u>polyolefins</u>) impregnated with <u>carbon black</u> to make it <u>electrically conductive</u>. It is used for the protection of items or devices that are susceptible to damage from <u>electrostatic discharge</u>

it is becoming popular with hobbyists for making inexpensive sensors for microcontroller experiments. One example of this is to make shoes which light up when the wearer takes a step. Since the <u>resistance</u> in the circuit is reduced when pressure is applied, this reading can indicate when weight is applied or removed from the shoes.^[4]

Michael Menkin, inventor of the thought screen helmet

Michael Menkin was a Lieutenant (junior grade) in the U. S. Coast Guard Reserve. He is a 46 year member of the U.S. Naval Institute and a 19 year member of the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON). He is also a 32 year member of Sons of the American Revolution.

Mr Menkin, as described by himself. A fellow-member of MUFON.

According to Menkin's website:

Possible alien weaknesses (grays only)

Reliance on telepathy

When the alien's telepathic powers are neutralized by the "thought screen helmet" they do not attempt to abduct their victims. Without their telepathic power they cannot render their victims passive.

What he has done, if he is right, is actually design a "tinfoil hat" that works. Since telepathy works, and involves some non-conventional commication among individuals (humans or other species) he may have found a means of partially controlling it.

According to Menkin, Grays are aggressive about abducting their "regulars." This is how you deal with them:

- 1. Prepare for a fight.
- 2. Have a locked cabinet.
- 3. Make the helmet quickly.
- 4. Secure the helmet with tape or string.
- 5. Don't be lured out of your current location by the aliens.
- 6. Make small holes in top for hot climates.
- 7. Wear the helmet as often as possible.

Grays won't give up without a fight, according to Menkin. They'll even try to discourage you telepathically from wearing your thought screen helmet. So keep it safe, keep it close, and wear it a lot of the time!
